

We will strive to lead and shape the congregational song every Sunday at the 8:00 a.m. worship service through July.

Prayer is ...

Well, what is prayer to you? Henri Nouwen writes this: Prayer "is a way of being empty and useless in the presence of God and so proclaiming our basic belief that all is grace and nothing is simply the result of hard work." This month, God will be bringing many children (and their parents!) to Epiphany for this year's VBS. We know that if His Gospel is to bear fruit, He will do it: it's not just the result of our hard work. In the next two weeks, prior to and during the week of VBS, we are asking you to pray over that event. If you are comfortable praying for this on your own, please do so! If you would like specific things to pray about—good news—at all services on June 11 there will be a handout with items for which you can pray.



Pray over this event. If you can only pray for one thing, ask God to open doors into the community for His Gospel. He is far more willing to give than we are to ask!

Periodically I am asked to suggest books to read. Over the summer months when the "living is easy" it is a good time to relax and feed the mind (and soul). While the best book of all is the Bible there are some other excellent books I consider "must reads" for their inspiring Christian message. So here is "Pastor Jon's Suggested Reading List":

- #1. <u>The Hiding Place</u> This is the Corrie Ten Boom story, a Christian who was arrested during World War II for hiding Jews from the Nazis. It will make you think hard and long about sacrificial love.
- #2. <u>The Cost of Discipleship</u> Written by Lutheran Pastor and Professor Dietrich Bonhoeffer who was martyred by the Nazis. This is a call to consider the cost of following Christ in a fallen world.
- #3. <u>Bonhoeffer: Pastor, Prophet, Martyr, Spy</u> This is an excellent biography by Eric Metaxas on the life of Dietrich Bonhoeffer and his participation in the resistance movement against Adolph Hitler and the Nazis.
- #4. <u>The Case for Christ</u> This best selling book by Lee Strobel will help the reader see the overwhelming evidence behind the claims of the person of Jesus Christ. It will also equip the reader to defend his or her faith.
- #5. The Chronicles of Narnia These delightful children's books by C.S. Lewis present Christian themes in a very creative way. Parents can read these books to their children (I did and it was awesome.) and enjoy a summer vacation to the land of Narnia. If you only read one book in this series I highly recommend "The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe".
- #6. The Reason for God In the face of a world filled with skepticism, are there good reasons to believe in Jesus Christ? Author, Timothy Keller sets forth a great defense of the Christian Faith and challenges the arguments of skeptics who believe that a reasonable person cannot believe in the existence of God. It is challenging and insightful.
- #7. <u>Crazy Love</u> Few books have challenged my walk with Jesus over the past few years like this book by Francis Chan. In view of God's crazy love for us, how can we not respond in kind? Be prepared to be convicted and encouraged by this wonderful little book.
- #8. <u>Simply Jesus: A New Vision of Who He Was, What He Did and Why it Matters</u> The title says it all. N.T. Wright is a brilliant scholar who cuts through a lot of the muck and mire to get to the heart of the Christian Faith.
- #9. Mere Christianity This book, by C.S. Lewis, is one of the most influential Christian books of the 20th century. Be prepared to be challenged and enlightened by the wisdom and insights of this one-time atheist Oxford scholar turned outspoken Christian apologist.
- #10. <u>Mother Teresa</u> Few people have epitomized the life of love and service to the poor like Mother Teresa. This excellent biography by Kathryn Spink will delight as well as inspire and challenge the reader.

If you have the time to read some of the books on this list and would like to have a cup of coffee and talk about them I would love to meet with you. Happy reading!




MORE NEWS FROM EPIPHANY'S LWML ...


