Upon affirmation by the applicant of intention to fulfill such duties as are required of a Voting Member to the best of their ability, the individual shall be accepted as a Voting Member at the end of that Voters' Assembly with all the rights and privileges pertaining there-to. The individual shall be required to sign the official copy of the Constitution and Bylaws of the Congregation at that time signifying acceptance into Voting Membership.
