#### PRAYER SERVICE FOR GOD'S HEALING

On Sunday, February 18 at 5:00 p.m. in the sanctuary we will, once again, hold a special service of prayer seeking God's healing. This is a service of prayer for the sick and suffering which includes the ancient tradition of anointing with oil by the pastor and the laying on of hands by the pastor and the elders.



James, the half brother of our Lord Jesus wrote, "Is any one of you in trouble? He should pray. Is anyone happy? Let him sing songs of praise. Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the church to pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord.". (James 5:13-14)

You are invited to attend this service on Sunday evening to either receive prayer and anointing by the pastors and elders or to give your support to those who are seeking God's intervention in their time of need.

#### **ARE YOU LISTENING?**

A few years ago, my daughter got me a wonderful devotional book entitled, *A Year With Dietrich Bonhoeffer*. Bonhoeffer was a Lutheran pastor in Germany during World War II who took an active role in fighting against Hitler and the Nazis. He was executed shortly before the end of the war. This is part of the devotion for January 10: "Many people seek a sympathetic ear and do not find it among Christians, because these Christians are talking even when they should be listening. But Christians who can no longer listen to one another will soon no longer be listening to God either; they will always be talking even in the presence of God. The death of the spiritual life starts here ... ". (12)

In a matter of weeks we will be entering into the Season of Lent. We often describe Lent as a time of repentance and renewal and so it is. But, I want to challenge you to make Lent a time of **listening**: **listening** first to God and **listening** to others.

Here are some specific things you can do during this Lent that will help you become better **listeners**:

- 1. Commit to weekly worship. Come to God's House and spend time listening to the words of life that He longs to share with you. Don't let other things become more important than hearing God speak. Make listening to the Lord your priority. Don't go to worship expecting to be entertained, but rather focus on listening to the voice of God. A person once asked, "Why doesn't God speak today like he did during Biblical times?" The truth is He does continue to speak today, but oftentimes we aren't listening.
- 2. Turn off the tv, the computer, and yes, even your cell phone for a time each day and talk to your spouse, your children, your friends or other important people in your life. One of the best gifts you can give people is your time. But as you give them your time give them your ears too!
- 3. As you make time for one another, talk about important things. Ask questions like: What are you concerned about? and What do you wish?
- 4. Ask your spouse, children or a dear friend to finish the following statement: "I feel loved when ... ". Not only will you become a better **listener**, but your love will become more focused and meaningful.
- 5. Have quiet time each day to reflect upon what you are hearing. Life can get so noisy and hectic we end up missing much of what is important. Slow down and **listen** to the promptings of the Holy Spirit. He speaks most clearly in His Word (a great reason to have daily devotions) but He also can speak through the people in our lives if we will but **listen**.

On Sunday, January 28, Epiphany's youth will be passing out bags after the services. Fill the bags with nonperishable food and bring them back on February 4.



In the coming months, we will publicize more opportunities for you to serve both within Epiphany and outside in the community.










### **JANUARY TRIPS**


