I remember the first time I rode a 10-speed bicycle. It was supposed to be easy—a lot easier than the one speed I was accustomed to riding. When I jumped on my new bike, however, it was a nightmare. Make the commitment to come to Bible Class! Make the commitment to begin a daily Bible reading program. You can find a plan for "reading through the Bible in a year" on the back of the purple prayer sheet and weekly on our Facebook page. The more you do it, the easier it becomes. You will also discover that as you read God's Word and allow God to speak to you regularly, the more you will want to read God's Word and hear Him speak to you.

I can't think of a better New Year's Resolution than committing yourself to the study of the Word. Unless, of course, it is putting God's Word into practice in

our lives. Let January be the month you "get into gear" and get the new year off to a blessed start!

Joyfully serve the Lord Openly confess the Gospel Yearn to grow in God's Word The national Office of the LWML. The national Lutheran Women's Missionary


