THE LATEST FROM EPIPHANY'S LEADERSHIP COUNCIL

Epiphany's Leadership Council met for their regular monthly meeting on Sunday, December 3, 2017.

The following topics were discussed:

- A report from Pastor Jon included Epiphany's year-end worship attendance averages:
 2017 – 415, 2016 – 445, 2015 – 469, 2014 – 494, 2013 - 527
- Epiphany received over \$40,000 for Hurricane Harvey relief;
 \$31,000 was dispersed in October to thirty-one families. The remaining funds were dispersed by the end of 2017.
- ♦ On October 28, we celebrated the confirmation of 20 junior confirmands. In addition to this October celebration, Reformation Sunday on October 29 was a wonderful observance of 500 years of God's grace. Thank you to all the people who made this celebration so special.
- ◆ A committee of three Leadership Council members, three Elders and three called workers have met twice to discuss renovations in the sanctuary building. Jontè Greer reported that the Renovation Committee met to do preliminary planning for a high level overview of renovation needs. A Project Charter for the possible renovation was presented to the council and discussed.
- ♦ The budget for 2018 was approved by the Voters' Assembly at the November 12, 2017 meeting.

The next Leadership Council meeting is scheduled for Sunday, January 21 at 6:00 p.m. in room 202 of the AFLC. Congregation members are invited to attend the regular monthly Leadership Council meetings at any time.

THANK YOU FROM LINC

Thank you very much for all that you did to collect toys for LINC this year! What a blessing all of your toys were to our LINC churches!

As I kept receiving more requests for toys, I began to wonder if we would receive enough toys, but God is faithful and provides ... through churches such as yours! Please be sure to thank all who gave toys this year!

The toys we collected were disbursed to 13 of our LINC Mission churches of various ethnicities -Hispanic, Nigerian, Eritrean, Indian, Congolese, as well as to our house church, Adelphos, in the 3rd Ward which serves low income, single parent families.

Adelphos had an Open House for their community on December 23 and toys were made available to the parents to choose for their children. I know they felt very relieved to have toys to share with their children on Christmas!

I like redistributing the toys to our LINC Mission churches because I know that each child who receives these toys also gets to hear the true message and meaning of Christmas and learn of Jesus who came to be our Savior. Please pray that the seeds of truth that were planted in hearts this Christmas will grow in the coming year!

Helen Keller was once asked, "Is there anything worse than blindness?" She responded by saying, "Oh, yes! A person with sight and no vision." As we begin a brand new year, by the grace of God—how's your vision? What do you see in your future? What do you expect to accomplish for the Lord in 2018? Where is Jesus leading you in the coming year?

We don't have to merely speculate about it. The Prophet Isaiah writes these words for us to consider,

"Listen to me, you who pursue righteousness and who seek the Lord: Look to the rock from which you were cut and to the quarry from which you were hewn; look to Abraham, your father, and to Sarah, who gave you birth. When I called him he was but one, and I blessed him and made him many. The Lord will surely comfort Zion and will look with compassion on all her ruins; he will make her deserts like Eden, her wastelands like the garden of the Lord. Joy and gladness will be found in her, Thanksgiving and the sound of singing." (Isaiah 51:1-3)

The Lord, through Isaiah, is reminding us of an important truth. He is saying look to your past and you will see God's handiwork. You will see how God takes people who seem to be out of hope (like Abraham and Sarah) and changes their sadness into rejoicing. God reminds us that His love never changes and even as He was with us in the past, so He will go with us into the future.

How's your vision? Do you see God's faithfulness and gentle leading in your life? If so, you can face 2018 and, all the challenges it will bring, with confidence and enthusiasm. If you don't see the Lord, it is probably because you are looking at the wrong things. God encourages us to look to Him, to Abraham and Sarah, to Moses, to David, to Joseph and Mary. As we consider these saints we soon realize that nothing is too hard for God. No circumstance, no situation is too far gone that God can't transform it. Whether it is a marriage that is hanging by a thread, a job that is in a tenuous position, a family that is divided or a life that seems to be falling apart, there is a God who specializes in putting broken things back together again. He is the One who turns wastelands into beautiful gardens and deserts into paradise.

How's your vision? Unfortunately, there will be many who will have sight and no vision in 2018. The good news is it doesn't have to be us. For as we look to Jesus Christ He has promised us "Joy and Gladness, Thanksgiving and Singing."

May you have a great 2018 as the Lord helps us to fix our eyes on Jesus the author and perfecter of our faith.






Share the love of Christ on Super Bowl Sunday!
