THE LATEST FROM EPIPHANY'S LEADERSHIP COUNCIL

Epiphany's Leadership Council met for their regular monthly meeting on Sunday, April 23, 2017.

The following topics were discussed:

 Epiphany's worship attendance and membership numbers: baptized members -1311, communicant members - 1030, worship attendance average for 2017 - 444. Jonté Greer, President Scott Stewart, Vice-president Kim Garza Michelle Gilbertson Dale Green Jo Lauppe Ray Martinez Wayne Roberson Brent Snyder Renee Van Bramer Pam Van Maaren

- Easter attendance was around 850; this was about 100 people less than last year. During the three worship days of Holy Week (Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday), Epiphany had approximately 2200 people in worship.
- It was reported that Eggstravaganza was very successful. By taking the event "off-site" we saw more non-church members in attendance. Beth Milbrath, Chase Drake, Senior High Youth and a host of others helped to make this event so successful.
- Policies for Epiphany's governance continue to be updated and adopted. A policy concerning duties for an interim Church Administrator have been clarified and approved.
- The foundation for a sub-group and a committee has been formed to address the possible upgrading of Epiphany's sanctuary space. The group will discuss setting the necessary parameters for any suggested changes to the current sanctuary.
- The Leadership Council Nominating Committee will meet on April 27, 2017 to discuss possible candidates for the upcoming 2017-2020 term of the Leadership Council.
- The next regularly scheduled Voters' Meeting of 2017 is set for Sunday, June 18 at noon in the AFLC gym.
- The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Leadership Council will be Sunday, May 21 at 6:00 p.m. in room 202 of the AFLC.
