## Jesus and Vacation

Easter is done. The world is moving forward. Soon, summer will be upon us and we will be headed indoors, the beach, or places other than Houston, Texas to beat the heat, see family and enjoy the good creation God has given to us to steward. This is good! We are privileged to be able to do this.

But, I bet you didn't know Paul writes about vacations and the beach. He does! Paul says something about this in 2 Corinthians.

2 Corinthians 5:17ff. " ${ }^{17}$ Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! ${ }^{18}$ All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: ${ }^{19}$ that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. ${ }^{20} \mathrm{We}$ are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us."

Wherever you are, whenever you are there, including on vacation or at the beach, you are God's newly recreated ambassador in Christ Jesus! You are, in many ways, missionaries for Jesus at home, abroad, on vacation, at the beach and all points in between. In other words, you are always on mission for God. Exciting! So, here's the question: How are you going to shine the light of God's love on the people around you this summer as his emissary?

I'm glad you asked! While you may already have some ideas or practices that you do in order to shine His Light and bring the Gospel with you, maybe you'd like a few more ways of shining the Light this summer (and all year, if I'm honest). Here are some other thoughts:

1. Ask if you can pray with your waiter/waitress if you're eating out. This is so simple, but it is one way that we can bring Jesus with us to the people we engage at restaurants. I have never encountered anyone who was angry that I asked; most times, they are really receptive to it and will be glad you even cared enough to ask.
2. Ask God to give you opportunities to speak of Jesus. Paul asks for prayers that doors might be opened for him to share Jesus. Not a bad prayer! Jesus is so much more willing to give than we are to receive those opportunities. Just ask! And get ready. (How do you get ready?)
3. Stay in His Word. Be prepared to give a defense for the hopes that you have (maybe you prepared a seven-word statement for the Gospel during our Lenten series!); those spaces are all around us, and if we do number two constantly, number three will follow along.

These are just a few examples of how we can do this. But, take encouragement if this all sounds a bit frightening. Jesus tells His disciples that when they are going and discipling and teaching and baptizing, He will be with them always, to the end of the age.

Are you His disciple? Then He has promised to be with you as you do those things.
He is Risen! Happy Easter!



# MLLIARY EISLESTICKS 

The Serve Ministry is partnering with Faith Comes By Hearing to raise funds to send Military BibleSticks to our troops overseas. Each BibleStick includes the entire Audio Drama New Testament and selected Psalms chosen specifically for "warriors".

Many of the military personnel live in cramped quarters, are in uncomfortable and challenging circumstances and are working hard and putting in long hours. Many are simply too tired to read the Bible if they even have one. The Bible5tick is military tough, pocket-sized and low-light for safety in the field so soldiers can take God's Word with them into the most dangerous areas of the world. With God's Word in audio, it can go with them and sustain them in even the most difficult situations.

Our goal is to raise $\$ 7,500$ and send BibleSticks to 3 platoons ( 300 men .and women). ## Lutheran World Ingathering

For the annual Lutheran World Relief ingathering, the quilters of LWML donated 82 quilts and 9 fabric kits. These are then shipped to the underprivileged or in need throughout the world. The quilts might be used for warmth, bedding, shelter dividers or even to bundle up possessions when traveling or to escape unsafe or dangerous areas.

Earlier in the year the quilters donated 12 quilts to LINC-Houston.
Quilts are made from donated fabrics, also recycled fabrics. Used sheets, drapes, blankets or bedspreads are used as fillers in the quilts.
