

Still, Paul wrote to the church of God in Corinth. Meaning God's church is meant to thrive in any city and every circumstance in which we find ourselves. Paul's letter is as timely as ever. We will explore the anchoring truths of bearing treasures in jars of clay, meeting Christ through a pressing thorn, opening wide your heart in the midst of hurtful relationships and what it means to embrace the lost and lonely as ministers of the new covenant. Each of us has a message to proclaim and live by. Because of Jesus the old has gone, the new has come.

The Gospel of John describes Jesus as "the Word". God wants to say something important to us human beings. He is saying it through Jesus and John's purpose in writing his Gospel is clear: "These are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name." 


