

#### **Celebrate Life!**

About three weeks ago, my mom celebrated her 90<sup>th</sup> birthday. A lot has changed in the world since my mom was born. There have been ups and there have been downs, both in the world and in her life. Even though she can't walk much anymore and her chronic pain isn't getting any less, mom continues to be content. In the words of St. Paul, my mom has learned "to be content whatever the circumstances" (Philippians 4:11). With this godly contentment also comes the "peace that passes understanding" (Philippians 4:7) or maybe it's the other way around. Whatever the sequence, mom has it and it shows! From her wheelchair she continues to study God's Word, receive the Lord's Supper, provide sweets to those who care for her as well as being sweet to those who care for her. She greets people with a warm smile and is kind and gentle. She prays for her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. Additionally, even though she is on a fixed income, she continues to give generously to the Lord's work through her congregation. In short, at 90 years of age mom continues to celebrate life and her life is a testimony to the goodness and grace of her Savior, Jesus Christ.

I share this with you because, too often, I see people stressed out, struggling, overwhelmed, discontent and discouraged by life. But it doesn't have to be that way; ask my mom. She knows about pain, brokenness, difficulties and disappointment. She knows that life is not a bed of roses. And yet, she still knows there are roses! There is beauty! There is awe! She got a taste of it when she held her great-grandson for the first time on her birthday. Mom has learned to look for the little gifts of love and beauty in life and she knows they are there because God is there. Where Jesus is—there is love and beauty and grace.

This kind of life doesn't just happen. It is the result of a deep, abiding faith in Jesus Christ. Over the years the faith that was implanted in my mom's heart by the Holy Spirit has been nourished and nurtured. Her faith has grown, is strong and clings to the One thing that makes all the difference—her Savior. **What my mom has is what Jesus wants all of us to have.** And He is the One who provides it. As we begin a new year of Bible Studies, Sunday School and Small Groups, I encourage you to get into the Word and let the Word get into you. A life well-lived is a life that is well-fed by God. Eat the rich food of His Word and drink deeply from the living water of the Gospel. The more you eat, the more you drink, the more you will learn, as my mom has, that life really is worth celebrating every day because Jesus is with us.
