PRAYER SERVICE FOR GOD'S HEALING SUNDAY, OCTOBER 21, 2018 5:00 P.M. SANCTUARY

On Sunday, October 21 at 5:00 p.m. in the sanctuary we will, once again, hold a special service of prayer seeking God's healing. This is a service of prayer for the sick and suffering which includes the ancient tradition of anointing with oil by the pastor and the laying on of hands by the pastor and the elders.

James, the half brother of our Lord Jesus wrote, "Is any one of you in trouble? He should pray. Is anyone happy? Let him sing songs of praise. Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the church to pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord". (James 5:13-14)

You are invited to attend this service on Sunday evening to either receive prayer and anointing by the pastors and elders or to give your support to those who are seeking God's intervention in their time of need.

GETTING READY FOR WORSHIP

Worship is boring! I don't get anything out of going to church! The Bible doesn't speak to my life and what I'm going through! Can you relate? Have you heard that before? Have you, maybe, even said it yourself? If you never have, this article probably won't mean much to you. But, if you have struggled in worship or in the study of God's Word, keep reading because it could just possibly change your worship life.

First let me say there is no better way to experience a healthy spiritual life than to be immersed in the proper soil and allow the right nutrients to allow you to grow. Jesus once said in John 15:5-6, "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. If anyone does not remain in me, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned."

If you are not regularly studying God's Word, worshiping the Lord with your brothers and sisters in Christ and receiving the Lord's Supper: start immediately. If, however, you are doing those things but still seem like you are either stagnant or withering ask yourself if you are simply going through the motions or actually expecting God to touch you, speak to you and empower you for everyday living.

For example, the other day Linda was speaking to me but I wasn't paying attention. We were together, she was speaking to me, but I completely missed what she was saying because my mind was somewhere else. I wonder how often that happens in worship or Bible Study. Let me assure you that every time you study God's Word, receive the Sacrament and come into the Lord's House for worship, God is present and is speaking to you. We might just need to get ready to listen by preparing ourselves for an encounter with the Lord. Let me suggest a few things that can help you prepare to meet God through His Word and Sacraments:

- 1. Come expecting to meet God and be changed.
- 2. During the confession of sins make it personal. What are some specific things you need to get off your chest and confess to the Lord?
- 3. As the pastor announces the forgiveness of sins, realize that it is really Jesus who is wiping away your sins and allowing you to start over.
- 4. In the reading of the Scriptures and during the sermon imagine that you and the Lord Jesus are sitting alone and He is speaking His Word specifically to you. Expect to learn and grow because you are in the very presence of God.
- 5. As you respond to God's love in the songs, prayers and offering consider how the woman caught in adultery and saved by Jesus from those who would condemn and stone her would have responded (see John 8:1-11). Do you think she was excited? Amazed? Relieved? Thankful? How does your response to God's love in Christ reflect your appreciation of the new life our Savior gives you?

Make no mistake about it—Jesus wants you to grow, not wither. He wants you to be fruitful, not fruitless. He is present to bless you through His Word and Sacraments. Get the most out of your encounter with Christ by preparing your heart to meet Him.


I'm really looking forward to praising the Lord in the company of fellow believers in such a wonderful setting. *Cathy Ashcraft*






