

HERE WE STAND PROJECT UPDATE

Standing together, all generations present AFFIRMED that Epiphany supports proceeding to the design phase of the *Here We Stand Project*.

Standing together, Epiphany Lutheran Church authorizes the *Here We Stand* Committee to seek and procure funding to proceed to the design phase of the project (established at \$265,000 to \$340,000) and subsequently enter into contract with the architectural firm.

After careful evaluation of various funding models for the entire project, a recommendation will be presented for voter consideration and approval.

EXPECT A MIRACLE!

In the first chapter of Luke's Gospel the angel Gabriel reveals to Mary that she would become the Mother of God's Son, Jesus. Listen in on their conversation as it is recorded in Luke Chapter 1.

Mary: "How will this be since I am a virgin?"

Gabe: "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Holy Spirit will

overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God

... For nothing is impossible with God."

Mary: "I am the Lord's servant. May it be to me as you have said."

There are several things that jump out to me as I read and reread these glorious words from the Gospel of Luke. None, however, are more fascinating than Mary's response to this miraculous revelation. Notice she doesn't say, "Yeah, right!" Nor does she respond by saying something like, "No thanks, I like my life just the way it is." Neither does she say, "You don't expect me to believe THAT do you? I guess her response strikes me as odd, or at best unique, because so often in today's world skepticism, doubt and unbelief seem to be the normal response to the miraculous.

Gabriel said, "Nothing is impossible with God." The Bible repeats that message more than once. We saw how Mary responded to that statement, but how do we? Can God really change my life? Can God really make "all things work together for good for those who love Him and are called according to His purpose?" Most Christians would probably say "yes" to these questions. Of course, God can do it. God can do anything He desires. He's omnipotent!

Where most people have difficulty is in asking a follow up question: "Will God do it?" Will God change my life? Will God work good out of all situations that I face, as I seek His will? Mary believed God would and God did. God always keeps His Word. Unlike us God never breaks a promise, so what He's promised us in His Word He will do. WE AS GOD'S PEOPLE, THEREFORE, SHOULD BE EXPECTING TO FIND THE MIRACULOUS TAKING PLACE IN OUR LIVES.

But if you don't know what God's will is for your life, or if you don't know the promises God has made to you, how can you (through faith) expect them to be fulfilled? Mary knew the promise and she responded in faith. Will you? I want to challenge you to "JUST SAY 'YES'!" Find out the amazing promises of God through the study of His Word. Commit yourself to being involved in a Bible Study Group. Allow the Holy Spirit to work in your life with His life-changing promises.

The Prophet Hosea once wrote, "My people are being destroyed for the lack of knowledge." My prayer is that Epiphany will be a congregation that is committed to receiving the knowledge that God reveals through the study of His Word. Furthermore, may we respond with a bold and confident faith to the knowledge and promises of God; and like Mary, say "Yes" to our Lord's will. Finally, may we become sensitive to the Lord's dealings in our lives and expect the miraculous to happen.

Nothing is impossible with God!


A Choral Workshop Saturday, October 12, 9:00 – 11:00 A.M.

Psalm 68.5 Ministry

The Psalm 68.5 Ministry identifies the widows and the fatherless among Epiphany's congregation and communicates with them to determine if they have any special needs that the ministry and/or the church as a whole can address.

Psalm 68.5 plans special lunches and gatherings for the widows/ widowers based on seasonal activities including Epiphatinos. The ministry would also like to expand their ministry for the widows/widowers to include minor home improvement needs as they might arise. Those needs can range from hanging a ceiling fan to installing a garbage disposal to mending a fence.





For the fatherless kids, they work with the families to make the ministry's resources available to assist the kids in their participation in summer camps, etc. Psalm 68.5 would like to expand their ministry to include mentoring for fatherless kids to provide spiritual and emotional support as needed. Mentors can provide support, advice, friendship, reinforcement and constructive examples.

Psalm 68.5 is looking for volunteers to help communicate with the individuals regarding their needs, volunteers to help with the preparations for the gatherings, volunteers who are handy with tools to assist with minor home improvement needs and volunteers who could mentor fatherless children. As of 2015, more than 6.65 million people live in the greater Houston area (that number is even larger now). Here are some facts:
