

**Do you like to talk to others?** Our shut-ins would love a call or a visit from you. Contact the church office for information about our shut-ins.

Are you retired with time on your hands? We have members who need rides to the doctor for appointments or to the hospital for treatments. Contact the church office to be put on a list to provide transportation. Also, every eight weeks, Epiphany members deliver meals to shut-ins in the Pearland area. It only takes 2 1/2 to 3 hours one day during that week and it is greatly appreciated. Contact Lillian Barath to be added to the schedule.

Do you enjoy meeting new people? The Usher Ministry needs you! As an usher you would greet worshippers and give them service bulletins, assist worshippers in finding seating as needed, assist worshippers as needed in leaving and returning to the service, gather the offering, direct traffic flow during communion, count all service attendees, collect attendance registers and ready the church for additional services. You are asked to serve only own Sunday per month at the service you typically attend. If you are interested in serving as an usher, please contact Jeff Hartwig.

**Do you feel called to be a missionary?** You can be a missionary without saying a word or needing a passport when you participate in Bible Marking. We spread the gospel message by marking scripture verses that lead the way to salvation through faith in Jesus Christ. The marked Bibles are donated to LINC and other ministries. *GriefShare: Surviving the Holidays* is a helpful, encouraging seminar for people facing the holidays after a loved one's death. It is a two-hour special event that functions just like a typical GriefShare session.

The seminar features video interviews with counselors, grief experts, and other people who have experienced the holidays after their loved one's death and who offer practical suggestions and reassurance. These people share honestly about:

- Being prepared for surprising emotions that may hit over the holidays
- What to do about traditions and other coming changes
- How to handle holiday parties and invitations
- How to survive potentially awkward moments with other people
- Where to find comfort, strength and hope in a seemingly hopeless time

Those who attend will receive a Survival Guide filled with practical tips, encouraging words, journaling ideas and exercises for daily help through the holiday season.


### THE GIVING TREE
