



Time Presses On

Remember as a child when the odometer on your parent's car rolled over a hundred thousand miles? If it was getting close when we were on a trip, I'd watch that odometer for 20 miles just so I wouldn't miss the time it turned. We do that on New Year's Eve too. Many people will tune in to watch the ball drop so they can shout "Happy New Year" and watch 2019 give way to 2020. With each turn of the odometer, with each turn of the calendar, we are reminded that time presses on as we head down the road of life.

With each mile we travel, and with each "new year" on our journey through life, we encounter change. This is not the world my parents grew up in. This is not the world in which I grew up. Life is changing and it is changing quickly. Change is both exciting and scary. Change by its very nature takes us to a new place, an unfamiliar place, a place of uncertainty. HIGHLIGHTS FROM THE DECEMBER LEADERSHIP COUNCIL MEETING:

Two Epiphany officers are appointed annually in January; see the descriptions below. If interested in additional information, please call the church office.

* Secretary - This person prepares monthly minutes for the Leadership Council meetings and the three regular Voters' meetings. Also, some legal documents may need a signature.

* Treasurer - This person reviews the monthly financial statements of ELC and prepares a synopsis for the monthly Leadership Council meetings and the three regular Voters' meetings. Also, the Treasurer a

meetings and the three regular Voters' meetings. Also, the Treasurer assists in the preparation and presentation of the yearly budget to the Leadership Council, Budget Forum and Voters' Assembly.

Renovation - Two areas are being explored

- The LCEP/Laborers for Christ Ministry works with churches at minimum wage during construction phases and can offset these costs by 15-25%.
- Generis 30-day free trial contract can analyze Epiphany's giving patterns and potential. Gloo software analytics can supply types and formats of needed data.

Financial Update

- "Adding to Advent" Matching Gift Opportunity we have exceeded our goal of \$50,000.
- The yearly pledge amount is up 6% although the total number of pledging units is less than last year.


More than 29 years ago, the Souper Bowl of Caring began with a simple prayer from a single youth group:






THANK YOU
