The purpose of the loan is to fund construction, engineering, architectural, inspections, and other support services associated with the Here We Stand project. Said loan to be evidenced by a promissory note, executed by Epiphany Lutheran Church of Pearland, Texas, payable to the order of Texas District of The Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod, to be more fully described in a Deed of Trust of even date therewith, said note being secured by the liens therein created or mentioned against all property owned by Epiphany Lutheran Church. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED OR ACKNOWLEDGED, that the President and Secretary are authorized to negotiate the specific terms of the loan and directed to execute and deliver for and on behalf of said church, and in the name thereof, said note, deed of trust, and such other documents as Texas District may require. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the President and Secretary are hereby authorized to certify to the Texas District of the Lutheran Church – Missouri Synod that this resolution has been duly adopted, is in full force and effect, and is in accordance with the Constitution and Bylaws of Epiphany Lutheran Church. 	20	JL/JG

HISTORY

- Priorities from 2019 Congregational Questionnaire
 - Renovate Worship Space
 - o Increase Campus Visibility
 - o Increase Seating
 - Improve Space Utilization
- August 25, 2019: Voters approved motion to proceed to design, and for the HWS Committee to return with a recommended funding model for Voter Approval.
- February 20, 2020: Voters approved resolution to request \$250,000 loan from the TX District of the LCMS to fund engineering and architectural design services.
- April 3, 2022: Voters approved an updated resolution, in which the \$250,000 loan also funds other consultant services. Voters also approved the Stage 4 capital plan to proceed with design and fundraising activities that better reflects Epiphany's current needs (after the pandemic) and streamlines the schedule.
- November 13, 2022: Voters approved resolution on the strategy to (1) address and reduce the impact of the estimated rise in construction costs and project budget by contracting with a Construction-Manager-At-Risk, and (2) begin capital campaign activities.
