In loving response to Christ, the Servant, the Orphan Grain Train (OGT) movement encourages and enables God's people to share personal and material resources in bringing Christ's name and character to needy people both near and far. It is a Christian volunteer network that ships donated

food, clothing, medical and other needed items to people in 71 different countries including the United States.

Orphan Grain Train Houston is open every

Saturday from 8:00 a.m. - noon to receive donations of gently used or new, clothing, shoes and coats for adults and children. They are located at: 5040 E Sam Houston Parkway S in Pasadena.

Currently OGT Houston operates out of two sea van containers to receive and distribute items to missions, shelters for women, children, veterans and homeless ministries throughout Texas and the Gulf Coast region. International shipments will also be coordinated to support ministries abroad.

The new Servant Center/ Warehouse is under construction. Thanks to our Father for His faithfulness to the OGT ministry as they build on the foundation of Jesus.

Tentative plans are for the project to be completed in 2024. Watch for updates but

feel free to swing by the property to see the progress. The Center will be approximately 12,000 sq. ft. of which 7,000 sq. ft. will be warehouse. The building will also include a sorting and

packing area, 2 classrooms, a break room, restrooms and showers.

OUR COMMITMENT TO EMBRACE THE FUTURE

Epiphany hosted 168 kids for Vacation Bible School the week of June 3 - 7. There were 80+ volunteers who helped make this happen. And ... they raised \$2,770 for Isaiah 117 House!

Why do we do this? We do it because Jesus told us to. In Matthew 28:19 Jesus says, "go and make disciples of all nations,".

One of the ways Epiphany embraces children and young families is to disciple kids and their parents.

VBS is fun! Every song, Bible story, game, craft, science lesson points to Jesus and that he died on the cross to save us from our sins.

It's an opportunity to reach out to those who have no

church home and share the Gospel with kids who may only hear it one week a year.

Of the 168 kids who attended VBS, 19 put on their form that they had no church home. All of those families were called by a volunteer after VBS and Pastor Jon sent a follow-up letter. At least one of those families has subsequently attended worship.

VBS is an opportunity to create community in the church. Connections made during VBS can sometimes last a lifetime.

VBS gives volunteers a chance to serve and be the hands and feet of Jesus. Volunteers get a lot out of it too!
